DAY01 AIR PORT – NEGOMBO

Arrival at Bandaranaike International airport and transfer you to Negombo.

Depending on your arrival time, you could rest and recuperate at the hotel or explore the city's fishing village for its fresh exotic seafood, and the colonial Dutch Fort to observe the bustling seaside town and its dwellers as they go about their busy daily lives.

Optional simply lounge at the beach and enjoy some cold beverages and a special gourmet feast of a mixed seafood platter.

Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY02 NEGOMBO – PINNAWALA – KANDY

After breakfast, your chauffeur guide will transfer you to Kandy, the seat of the last King of Sri Lanka, with a stop at the Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage for your chance to get up close with the many orphaned and disabled elephants rehabilitated and cared for at the site. Get there by feeding time early in the morning hours to see baby elephants bottle fed milk, and then bathed in the Mahaweli River.

On arrival in Kandy, take a city tour after lunch and visit the fruit and vegetable markets, gem museums and curio shops, or take a stroll around the picturesque Kandy Lake. Views of the city from the popular Upper Lake Drive are especially nice.

In the late afternoon, be entertained by a colourful cultural music and dance performance before visiting the sacred Temple of the Tooth to pay your respects.

Kandy is the seat of the last King of Sri Lanka, Sri Wickrama Rajasinghe, with the Temple of the Tooth being the last Royal Palace Complex; hence Kandy has a special sense of culture and history that is evident in its art and traditional dance.

Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY03 KANDY – PERADENIYA – RAMBODA – NUWARAEIYA

After breakfast, depart for Nuwara Eliya and visit the Peradeniya Botanical Gardens on route – home to over four thousand species of exotic plant specimens, and view the spice gardens, orchid house, the natural pavilion fig tree, and many more beautiful sections.

From here, visit a traditional tea factory and see the tea pluckers at work and learn how to choose just the right tea leaf. Later on visit the famed Ramboda Falls.

Come late afternoon, take a walk around the town and stroll through the park, or visit the picturesque little Anglican Chapel, the horse racetrack, and the beautiful old colonial style golf club for some light refreshment.

Lake Gregory, in the heart of the town, is a great place for a stroll and promises some beautiful picture settings, in addition to the many public leisure activities offered along its banks such as boat rides etc.

Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY04 NUWARAEIYA – HORTON PLAINS

Early departure to Horton Plains, and World's End for an unforgettable trek through a unique biodiversity hotspot with rolling grassy plains and cloud forest, home to a wide variety of endemic flora and fauna including Leopards and the elusive Slender Loris.

Horton Plains lies in the midst of Sri Lanka's Central Highlands, an area designated as a World Heritage Site.

Late afternoon you could choose to relax and spend some leisure time at the hotel, or take a stroll through Nuwara Eliya town with its colonial architecture, Public Park, race course, and golf course.

Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY05 NUWARAEIYA – ELLA (BY TRAIN)

After breakfast at the hotel, your chauffeur will drive you to the Nanu Oya Train Station to begin a magical train journey through the winding misty hills to Ella, where he will await you for transfer to your hotel.

After lunch, stroll through Ella town, or choose between hiking up Little Adam's Peak, or up the famous Ella Rock. Other popular sites of interest in Ella are the Nine Arches bridge, and the beautiful Ravana Falls with its mysterious cave.

20 NIGHTS | 21 DAYS PROGRAM

DAY 01 AIRPORT – NEGOMBO

Arrival at Bandaranaike International Airport to a warm welcome from your chauffeur guide who will transfer you to Negombo, just six kilometres away.

Depending on your arrival time, you could rest and recuperate at the hotel or explore the city's fishing village for its fresh exotic seafood, and the colonial Dutch Fort to observe the bustling seaside town and its dwellers as they go about their busy daily lives. Alternatively, simply lounge at the beach and enjoy some cold beverages and a special gourmet feast of a mixed seafood platter.

Dinner and overnight stay at any selected hotels in Negombo.

DAY 02 NEGOMBO – ANURADHAPURA

Anuradhapura to visit the famed "Atamasthana" (Eight sacred sites), Jaya Sri Maha Bodhi, Ruvanvelisaya, Thuparamaya, Jethawanaramaya, Abhayagiri Dagoba, Mirisaveti Stupa, Lankaramaya, and Lovamahapaya.

Visit many other ancient sites such as the royal palaces, gardens, and bathing ponds – beautiful examples of ancient engineering and artistry.

After breakfast depart to Habarana - the hub of Sri Lanka's astonishing cultural triangle. On arrival at your hotel, you could choose to relax and lounge by the pool, or speak to your chauffeur guide to venture out on a guided trek through the village of Hiriwaduna for an authentic Sri Lankan village experience through the picturesque countryside. Head back to the hotel for some rest and relaxation by the pool, or optionally try out a jeep safari to the Minneriya National Park to see herds of wild elephant and other animals by the watering holes.

Additionally, an elephant back safari through the Habarana Lake can be perfect as a sunset excursion.

Overnight stay at Kandalama Hotel.

DAY 05 HABARANA - SIGIRIYA - DAMBULLA

After breakfast, travel to the Sigiriya Rock Fortress – the imposing ancient royal citadel in the jungle and climb up to walk among the ruins of the palace of King Kassapa while enjoying the amazing vistas of the surrounding wilderness. From there, head to the beautiful forested Polonnaruwa archaeological park and its stunning list of ancient structures – palaces, temples, tombs, and stupas.

Visits Dambulla for a visit to a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Dambulla Golden Temple, with its beautifully preserved examples of Buddhist art and sculpture within its extensive gold cave complex.

Transfer to the hotel for overnight stay.

DAY 06 HABARANA - DAMBULLA – KANDY

After breakfast, set out for the hill capital Kandy.

In transit to Kandy, stop at Matale for a walk through one of Sri Lanka's famous spice gardens, home to the world's highest quality cinnamon, cloves, cardamoms, pepper and other exotic spices. You can also enjoy an exotic wholesome Sri Lankan feast full of local flavour at the spice garden restaurant, and using the same spices grown on location.

Arrive in the historic hill capital of Kandy, and be entertained by the colourful cultural music and dance performance before visiting the sacred Temple of the Tooth - the repository of the sacred tooth relic of the Lord Buddha to pay your respects.

Overnight at stay at the hotel.

DAY 07 KANDY – PINNAWALA – PERADENIYA

After breakfast head to the stunning Royal Botanical Gardens in Peradeniya for a walk through some of the finest specimens of botanical life in the near 200 year old gardens. Spread around 59 hectares it boasts over 4000 species of tropical plants and trees including orchids, bamboo, spices, medicinal plants, and amazing palms lined up along the many picturesque walkways.

After visit the Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage and view orphaned and disabled elephants being cared for and rehabilitated. Enjoy lunch while watching the elephants bathe in the Mahaweli River.

Enjoy an evening of shopping and a city tour with a visit to Upper Lake Drive for the best view of the city and some iconic photographs. A walk through the market is also recommended for a look at the local fruits and vegetable, and the arts and crafts shops with traditional Sri Lankan batiks, gems and brassware, and many curio and gift shops to peruse at your own pace. The Kandy Lake promises vibrant sunsets during an evening stroll around its banks and is great setting for some holiday photographs.

Overnight at stay at the hotel.

DAY 08 KANDY – PINNAWALA – PERADENIYA

Breakfast at the hotel. Full day at leisure at the hotel.

Optional – Attend to a cooking class in Kandy.

DAY 09 KANDY – RAMBODA - NUWARAELIYA

After breakfast, head out to the colonial hill station of Nuwara Eliya – the heartland of Ceylon Tea, and called Little England due to its cool climes and misty mountains popular among expats in colonial times.

On the way, stop by at the stunning Ramboda Falls and hike up to the top for some amazing natural scenery - make sure you take your camera with you. Afterwards visit a traditional tea factory and watch the tea pluckers at work and learn how they choose just the right tea leaf.

Arrive in Nuwara Eliya and take a walk around the town after lunch and stroll through the park, or visit the picturesque little Anglican Chapel, the horse racetrack, and the beautiful old colonial style golf club for some light refreshment.

Lake Gregory, in the heart of the town, is a great place for an evening adventure promising some beautiful picture settings in addition to the many public leisure activities offered along its banks such as boat rides etc.

Overnight at stay at the hotel.

DAY 10 NUWARAELIYA

Breakfast at the hotel. Visits Hakgala Botanical Garden and return back to the hotel.

Rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight at stay at the hotel.

DAY 11 NUWARAELIYA – ELLA

After breakfast at the hotel, your chauffeur will drive you to the Nanu Oya Train Station to begin a magical train journey through the winding misty hills to Ella, where he will await you for transfer to your hotel from the train station.

After wholesome local lunch at a recommended restaurant in Ella town you can explore the area and its environs, and choose from the many sights on offer in the vicinity such as the famed Ella Gap, the Nine Arches Bridge, Little Adam's Peak, or Ella Rock for some scintillating vistas.

Overnight at stay at the hotel.

DAY 12 ELLA – YALA

Depart Ella after breakfast for the Yala National Park, and arrive at your hotel by lunchtime, after which you may spend your day resting by the pool and readying yourself for the excitement of a spectacular wildlife adventure to come the following day.

Overnight at stay at the hotel.

DAY 13 YALA

Depart early morning equipped with a packed breakfast, courtesy of the hotel, for your wild adventure inside Yala where you will be treated to some amazing sights and sounds, and keep a keen eye out for the elusive leopard.

Rest of the day at leisure.

After breakfast depart for the Sinharaja Rainforest, Sri Lanka's pristine lowland rainforest with a high percentage of endemic species among its animal and bird life.

Rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 15 YALA – SINHARAJA RAIN FOREST

After breakfast, venture out on a guided walk into the Sinharaja Rainforest to catch glimpses of the many rare and endemic species of mammals, reptiles, amphibians, birds, and butterflies. Sinharaja has a very high percentage of endemic species of fauna, with the forest itself considered a prime example of pre-continental shift landscape.

Spend the rest of your afternoon resting and recuperating from your walk at the hotel surrounded by nature.

Overnight stay at any selected hotels in Sinharaja.

DAY 16 SINHARAJA RAIN FOREST

Breakfast at the hotel. Full day at leisure. Stay overnight at the hotel.

DAY 17 SOUTH BEACH

Afterwards, your chauffeur will transfer you to the sunny beaches and warm crystal clear waters of southern Sri Lanka, where you can stop by in the city of Galle - a former Dutch colonial bastion.
