All the travellers arriving in Sri Lanka via airport shall mandatorily fill the online Health Declaration Form individually and upload the relevant documents (Vaccination record, Predeparture COVID – 19 negative test report, Data page of the Passport etc.) prior to boarding. They should arrive with the QR code (in mobile phone / hard copy) issued to them.

This direction will come true from 2022.01.01

Please note that only the Travellers of twelve years and above arriving in Sri Lanka should mandatorily carry a negative COVID-19 PCR test report in English language done within 72 hours prior to embarkation.

If the travellers have a history of COVID-19 infection during the last three months, instead of a PCR test, they could arrive with a negative COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Test report done within 48 hours prior to embarkation. They should carry a diagnosis card or verifiable evidence or positive PCR report or positive Rapid Antigen Test report as a proof of past history of illness (in English)

Travel restrictions for Travellers arriving from, South Africa, Botswana, Lesotho, Namibia, Zimbabwe and Eswatini (Swaziland) issued by the Director General of Health Services (DGHS) on 26.11.2021 is hereby cancelled.
