IMF Approves US\$3 Billion Under the EFF Arrangement for Sri Lanka

The IMF Board approved a 48-month extended arrangement under the Extended Fund Facility

(EFF) of SDR 2.286 billion (about US\$3 billion) to support Sri Lanka's economic policies and

reforms.

President Ranil Wickremesinghe expressed his "gratitude to the IMF and our international

partners for their support as we look to get the economy back on track for the long term through

prudent fiscal management and our ambitious reform agenda". He added this will enable "Sri

Lanka to access up to US\$ 7 billion in funding from the IMF and IFIs"
