Entry Requirements to Sri Lanka relaxed following improved Sri Lankan and Global Pandemic Control Efforts

- 1) Fully vaccinated travellers to Sri Lanka who have completed 14 days after recommended doses of vaccination and arriving with a negative COVID-19 PCR Report done within 72 hours of embarkation/negative COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Test report done within 48 hours prior to embarkation will be released from airport and do not need to do Day 1 PCR test or undergo quarantine after arriving Sri Lanka.
- 2) If COVID-19 like symptoms develop, they should conduct a COVID-19 test from a Ministry of Health approved laboratory and produce the report to area Medical Officer of Health (MOH)
- 3) Travellers of **two years and above** arriving in Sri Lanka should mandatorily carry a negative **COVID-19 PCR test report** in English language done within **72** hours prior to embarkation.
- 4) **Travellers** with a history of COVID-19 infection **during past three months** may arrive with a **negative COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Test report done within 48 hours prior to embarkation**. They should carry a diagnosis card or verifiable evidence or positive PCR report or positive Rapid Antigen Test report as a proof of past history of illness (in English).
